Female Body Armor

Dear Purchaser:

This vest is a life-saving piece of equipment that has been manufactured especially for you. It is based on your individual measurements provided. We believe it will not only offer you superior ballistic protection but also be comfortable while doing so. In order to ensure proper fit, we need your help.

Please follow the directions listed below:

1) If the straps are not attached to the vest when you receive it, you will need to place them on the panels.

Attach the shoulder straps connecting front to back. These can be adjusted to fit once you have the vest on.

You will have two straps on each side connecting back to front. Attach one Velcro waist strap slightly angled upward along the bottom edge of the back panel.

Then secure the second strap above the first strap horizontally on the back. Repeat with the other side.

2) Put the vest on, using only the shoulder straps, so the front panel is lying against your front, and the back panel is against your back. We then ask that you form the front panel to your shape. Take and firmly fold the sides inward and the front panel around, so it forms to your chest area to create an area for your breasts. Then secure side straps. If you do this each time you put your vest on, it will conform to your body.

Secure the side straps, adjusting as needed. Make sure to have the angled strap correspond to the angled matching piece. If the straps are too long, move the rear straps closer to the center on the back.

Adjust the shoulder straps so that the vest is in the proper position and fitting comfortably over the shoulders. The side straps should fit snug but not overly stretched.


For maximum comfort, please follow these steps. Your vest should fit snug but not tight. Please do not hang your vest, as this will cause the elastic shoulder straps to stretch.

CORRECT STRAP PLACEMENT ON A SURVIVAL ARMOR CONCEALABLE FEMALE CARRIER

- 1: Place the elastic strap on the front carrier. The first piece of elastic should attach to the top of the loop. The second piece of elastic should attach to the bottom of the loop. If adjustments are needed, adjust the hook strapped to the back panel (as shown in diagram).
- 2: Next, pull the other side of the strap that joins both pieces of elastic and strap it to the back carrier making a small angle.
